

Greater Hudson Valley Council Camps Shooting Sports Range – Cleaning Protocols

Shooting tables need to be covered with plastic sheeting.

Shooting tables and gun rest need to be cleaned between each shooter with disinfectant or sanitizing wipe.

Shooting tables need to be a minimum of 6 ft. apart.

Only persons shooting can be on the range with the RSO and Rifle Instructor.

There needs to be one person designated to go down range and change targets.

No sharing of eye and hearing protection. Shooter must have their own.

Shooters should enter and exit range through different areas.

Hand sanitizer shall be used when entering and exiting the range.

One person should distribute ammo. Wearing gloves, place ammo into a disposable cup. Do not use ammo blocks.

Wipe down guns before and after use with 70% or greater alcohol-based sanitizer wipes, and then gun oil at the end of the day.

All persons on the range need to wear masks at all times.

REMOVE ALL GARBAGE AT THE END OF THE SHOOT.
