Rental Agreement regarding Condition & Return of Bicycle



Limitations of Use.

Operator (or as Operator's Minor Child's parent or guardian) agrees to use the Bicycle only on designated and approved trails or roads. Operator agrees to use the Bicycle safely at all times, to wear appropriate safety and protective Equipment, such as a helmet and protective clothing, not to operate the bicycle in areas where prohibited or exposed to unusual danger, and to yield to pedestrians, especially in crowded areas. Operator agrees to park bicycle as designated, never leaving on the ground or in road/walkways. Operator agrees to always abide by the Buddy System.

Condition and return of bicycle.

Operator must return the bicycle and equipment to the Specified Office on the date and time stated in this agreement, and in the same condition that operator received it except for ordinary wear. Service to the bicycle or replacement of parts or accessories during the rental is NOT authorized – please contact the Summit Base Director or Central Office in the event of any concerns regarding the bicycle.

Responsibility for Loss or Damage.

Operator accepts full responsibility for the retail value of the bicycle and will reimburse Provider the full amount, plus rental fees, for damages resulting in a total loss such as: theft, vandalism, confiscation/impoundment, fire, damage by others, crash where due to negligence by operator or others. Operator accepts responsibility during possession of the bicycle and equipment for repairs beyond the normal use. Operator is responsible for theft of the bicycle and equipment, loss of use, diminished value caused by damage to it or repair of it, and a reasonable charge to cover our administrative expenses connected with any damage claim, whether or not operator is at fault.
