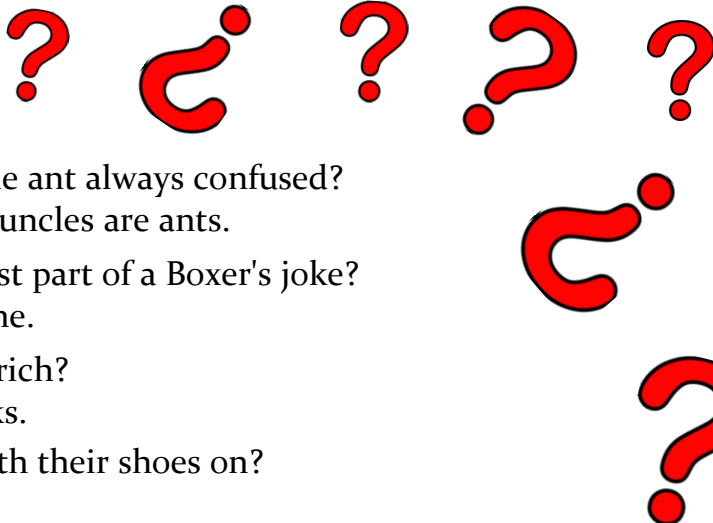

## Looking for Elangomats!

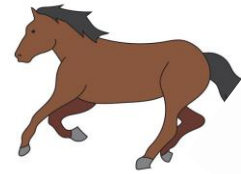

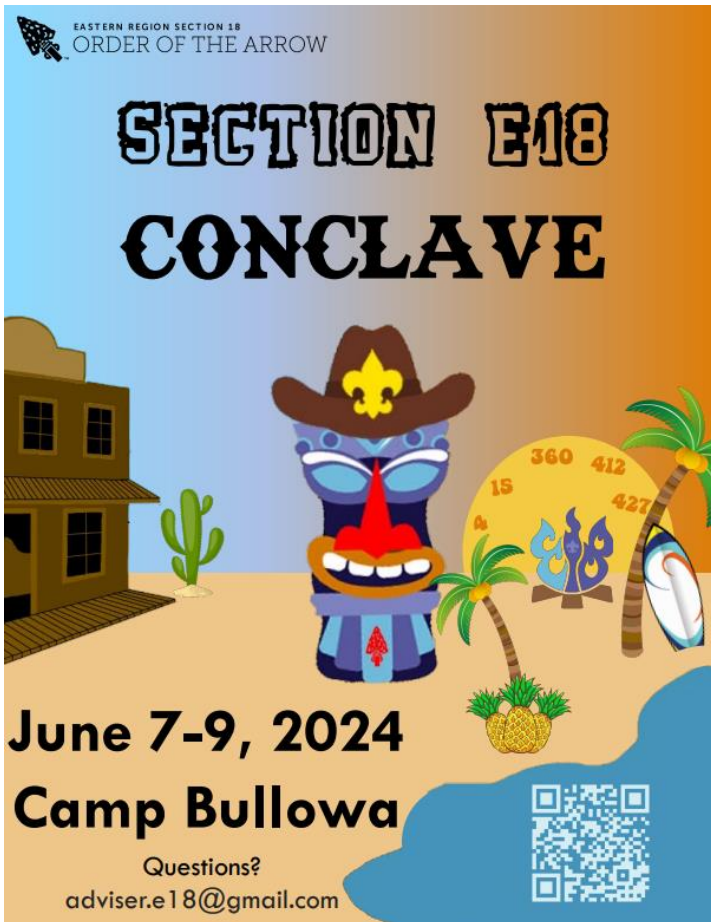


## Conclave!

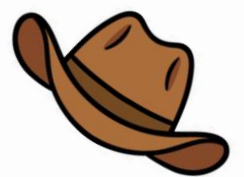
