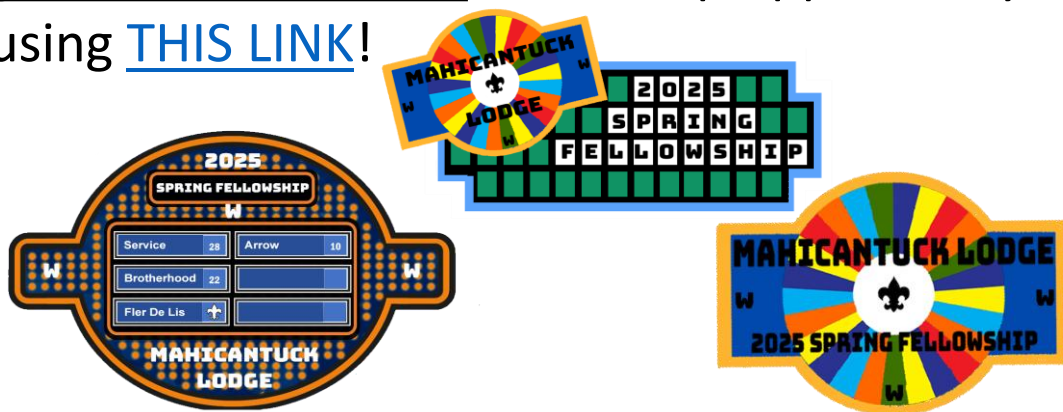




## !!Spring Fellowship!!
