

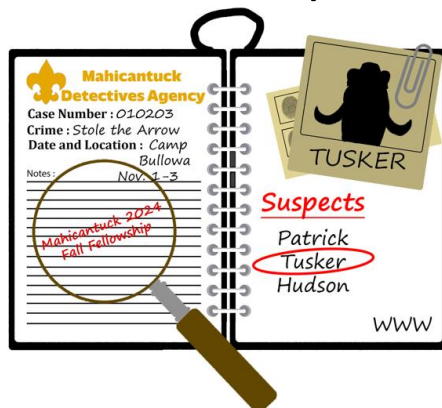


Fall Fellowship
